FAFSA - Seniors planning to attend college next fall should log onto <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa> and set up your FAFSA account and submit your application to determine how much financial aid you will receive from federal funds. There is no charge to file the FAFSA. The application will ask about student and parent assets and income for tax year **2022**. After completing FAFSA you will be prompted to complete the NYS Tap Application. Some colleges also require you to complete the Profile. More information on financial aid is available at:
