The building condition survey is due to the State Education Department by January 15, 2016. The District will use the report as a basis for any potential development of a capital improvement project should it become necessary. The report is pending from AES Northeast at this time.

The Town of Bolton appears to be making progress with the amount of fill being transported to the Town Recreation field. Department of Environmental Conservation coordination is still pending at this time. The committee will provide more information as it becomes available.

The next meeting of the Facilities Committee will be scheduled once a draft of the building condition survey is available for review.
