In Math, BCS students ranked 7<sup>th</sup>and in English, BCS students ranked 4<sup>th</sup>. We are proud of the achievements of our students and look forward to sharing their bright future with our community. The District was not ranked at the high school level due to having less than 20 students take the SAT exam. Our elementary program moved to 16<sup>th</sup> place.
