7. **INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM**

A. Strategic Planning – Steering Committee Report

Mr. Shippee reported on the second semester strategic plan goals. There is research being done to set up a Math Club for middle school students with the hope of starting in the fall of 2017. A Parent Resource Newsletter will be available for parents this spring. Our high school STEAM lab is in the works. Other STEAM activities planned for this spring will include a STEAM Fair in May and two elementary trips to the Museum of Innovation and Science.
